The Scott Mission offers: hot meals (served twice a day, six days a week); daily bag lunches; a low-cost childcare centre; a summer camp and after-school program for children and youth from low-income families; free good-quality clothing; groceries; shower and laundry facilities for the homeless; a 45-bed shelter; and out-of-town retreats for shut-ins.
