The Scott Mission Camp in Caledon, ON may be a wonderful location for your next retreat. Whether you are looking for a place to go for a personal retreat or looking to run a church camp for 150 people, we have a variety of accommodations to meet your needs.

Located about 1 hour, northwest of downtown Toronto, Scott Mission Camp is situated on 100 acres of rolling hills, forests and meadows. Our guests can explore our many hiking trails and outdoor spaces. We have tennis/basketball courts, a soccer field, a playground, a hill for tobogganing in the winter and a pond for canoeing and fishing.

Accommodations

The Lodge is our primary rental building in Caledon. It has comfortable accommodations for up to 23 guests. There is a large room with comfortable couches and a fireplace. On the lower level, there is a games room and a large multi-purpose room that can be used for meetings and dining. Just off the multi-purpose room is a kitchen for meal preparation.

In the vicinity of the Lodge are two cosy two bedroom cabins. Each cabin can sleep 4-5 people. These cabins can be used as over-flow sleeping accommodations for large groups using the Lodge, giving a total occupancy for a group of up to 32 people.

During the month's of May, June, September and October, the facilities we use for our summer camp are available to rental groups. There are beds for 150 guests, a large dining hall and a commercial kitchen.

Availability

The Scott Mission uses the camp for our own summer camp programs late-June to the end of August. Please contact us to confirm availability.



The Collingwood Lodge is a place of peace and quiet away from the noise, distractions and pressures of the city. With breath taking views of the City of Collingwood and Georgian Bay, you will enjoy the wonders of God's creation everywhere you look.

The Lodge is located on 113 beautiful acres on Blue Mountain. Guests can enjoy local attractions like the quaint shops of downtown Collingwood, the Blue Mountain Ski Resort and Wasaga Beach.

Accommodations

The Lodge has comfortable accommodations for up to 16 guests in the motel building. The barn has two bedrooms, a large room with couches and a fireplace. Also in the barn is a large kitchen and eating area. The motel is a dormitory style building with 8 rooms. Connecting the two building is a magnificent deck that provides panoramic views.

Availability

While The Scott Mission programs have priority, we do rent to church groups when there are vacancies. The Lodge is available year-round, although access can be limited in the winter due to the steep access road and snow accumulation.
